Cross Section

Framing an Adventurer truck camper is a craft in itself. All materials are pre-cut and hand assembled without the use of jigs to provide a tighter, stronger fit at all of the joints.



- All external walls are insulated with high density styrofoam insulation for heat retention and sound dampening.
- 1 Large emergency egress window.
- 12 Floor on overhead bed is bolted in place with 31/4" bolts on each side.
- At Adventurer we manufacture our own Filon™ to exact specifications to ensure our products are always up to our high standards. We use only the best building materials, from aluminum tubing to quality solid wood cabinet doors; absolutely no particle board is used.
- Aluminum framed composite panel roof is the same as in all exterior walls. T.P.O. rubber roof with a prorated 12 year warranty is available as standard equipment.
- 15 Moulded fiberglass nose caps are available.






