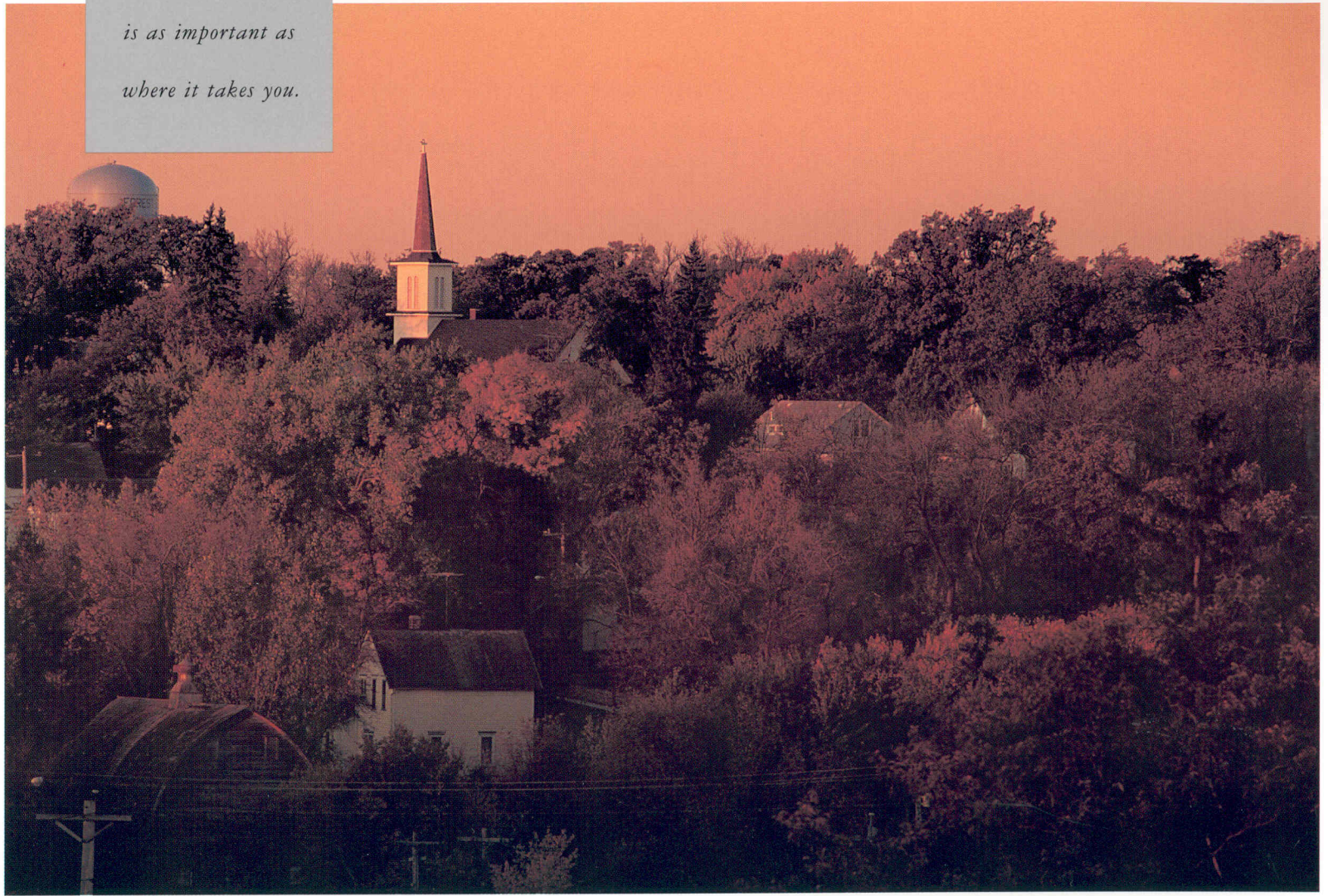

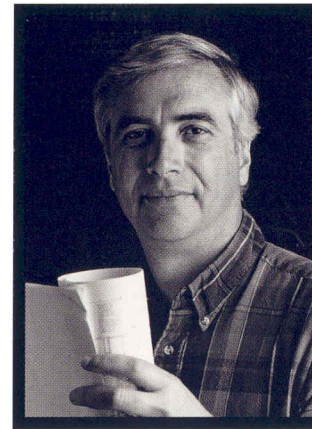

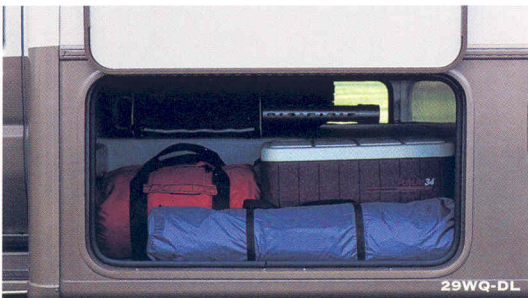

That's why we design efficient floorplans based on customer input. And why we look for durable fabrics in pleasing colors. We call this Home Comfort Design. To find the most durable fabrics, we follow the furniture industry's wear duty ratings. Then we conduct double rub tests which simulate getting in and out of a seat over 15,000 times. For carpet colors that remain true, we use only materials with color extruded into the fibers, not just dyed on the surface. And unlike other manufacturers who use jute carpet backing, ours is hypoallergenic and stain- and mildew-resistant. Finally, we protect all upholstery and carpeting against stains with Scotchgard™ Brand Soil Repellent.

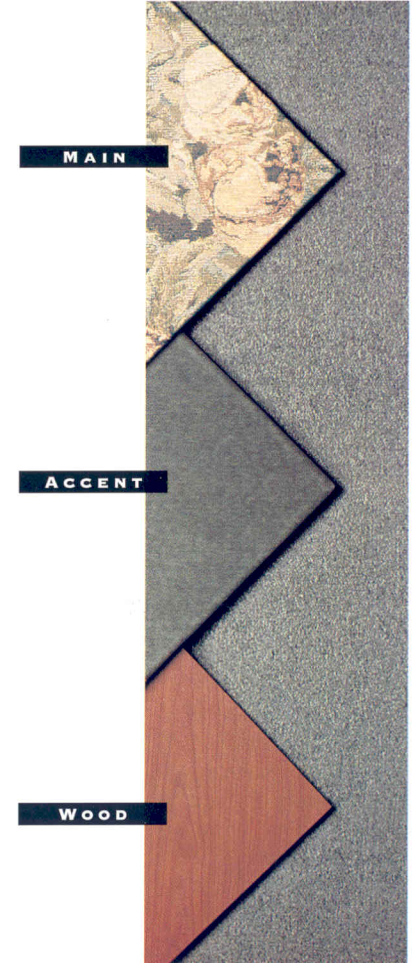

We manufacture more than 80 percent of everything that goes into our motor homes. And when you figure the average motor home has some 3,000 parts, that's a big job.



These plastic pellets will eventually be ground into a powder and then poured into a mold which is heated and rotated in all directions. This method, called rotocasting, forms strong, seamless holding and water tanks.

It's no wonder other motor home companies would rather assemble parts they buy from outside suppliers than make their own.

The reason we do it our way is simple. It lets us keep greater control over the quality



of the finished product.

For example, we fabri-

cate our own holding

tanks so we can design

them to fit the frame,

instead of the other

way around. That helps us maintain the structural integrity of the frame and also distribute

weight more evenly. Which pays off in a

motor home that's built better

and handles better.

We invented Thermo-Panel® sidewall construction which combines light weight, structural integrity and durability.

Our exclusive interlocking joint system connects the floor and walls to make a more durable, better-sealed body.

Seamless rotocast holding tanks make the best use of space and improve weight distribution.

Only Winnebago Industries subjects every new series to a computerized drop test that simulates dropping the unit upside down. This ensures that appliances and cabinets stay in place and that doors and windows operate.

More storage space has been added including this new exterior compartment.

The basement has heated compartments for the fresh water tank and holding tanks.

Molded wheel wells are non-corrosive and absorb sound better than metal.

All units are pre-wired for an available roof air conditioner.

All models are widebodies with full basement storage.

Appliances are secured with steel tie-downs, an exclusive Winnebago Industries safety feature.

The metal substructure is laser-aligned and welded directly to the chassis frame rails to provide a square foundation.

All welds are painted to prevent corrosion.

Welded tubular aluminum framework is strong yet lightweight.

The new standard service center puts the water fill, valves, power cord and water pump switch in one convenient, heated compartment.

Radius corners on compartment doors eliminate sharp edges.

There can be more than 5,500 feet of wire in a motor home. We letter code ours to make service diagnosis easier and faster. We also use automotive-style plug ins and rubber grommets to protect areas where wire passes through the chassis.



Wiring harnesses are built and tested in our wire prep department, and the electrical system is tested throughout the manufacturing process.

Welded framework is strong enough to pass a drop test, yet light to maximize fuel efficiency and weight-carrying capacity.

An entertainment center and slideout bunk are available. Standard models have a front window in the bunk area.

Windows have a non-hardening butyl sealant to prevent leakage.

For added safety, upper cabinets are secured to metal plates in the sidewall and roof.

We add strategically placed steel angles to reinforce roof and wall joints.

Only Winnebago Industries adds a steel pillar in the bunk area to increase rigidity and occupant safety.

Foam sheet insulation prevents energy leaks and gaps in sidewalls.

Each unit receives a final inspection in which we check all dash functions as well as the fit and finish of the entire vehicle.

Smooth, one-piece fiberglass skin is strong, easy to clean, and free of exposed fasteners and bolts.

Every unit undergoes a water test simulating a rainfall of 50 inches per hour.

Color-coordinated valance is part of the available DL package.

Exterior compartment doors are laminated with fiberglass skin on both sides and block foam insulation in the center for energy efficiency and sound absorption.

Every unit is checked by computer for wheel alignment and checked at 75 chassis points.

Our locks are endurance and corrosion tested.

The body is attached to the floor supports which, in turn, are fastened to the Ford rubber isolation system. This reduces noise and vibration and helps provide a more enjoyable ride.

Because we are immersed in the manufacturing process, we often find better ways to do things. Take the way we insulate our sidewalls.

In other motor homes, insulation is cut to fit inside the framework. We form insulation to fill the size of the entire sidewall and carve

grooves for the framework to slide into. The insulation encloses the frame rail, which eliminates gaps and condensation.

We also make hundreds of vacuum-formed plastic parts. We have our own metal stamping shop. We even make many of our own sofas and chairs and all cabinetry.



We use an advanced computer-aided design system where our designers consider many options before determining a final design.

And what about the 20 percent of parts we don't make (like TVs, stereos and appliances)?

You can bet we're just as picky about those.

Our suppliers have proven they are always willing to go back to the drawing board if a change will benefit our customers.
